CSDCI conducted "Mega Rozgar Mela & Skill Exhibition" at Cuttack, Odisha

Construction Skill Development Council of India (CSDCI) under the patronage of National Skill Development Council (NSDC) and Skill India conducted a two-day long "Mega Rozgar Mela & Skill Exhibition" at L&T CSTI, Cuttack, Odisha on 27th and 28th February 2019. More than 40 companies including L&T, Vastu Vihar, HRM Constructions, SPD Constructions participated in the Rozgar Mela. The Rozgar mela was inaugurated by CEO, CSDCI. The closing ceremony & offer letter distribution ceremony was witnessed by Shri Pitambar Acharya, Senior Advocate, BJP Spokesperson Odisha as Chief Guest & Air commodore P.C. Grover, Director General, National Highways Builders Federation (NHBF) as Guest of Honor. Token appointment/offer letters were handed over by dignitaries to candidates.



Total 3300 vacancies were offered to the candidates which included jobs of other than construction sector also. On first day 900+ candidates were registered and on second day 200+ candidates were registered. At the end of the Rozgar Mela over 400+ candidates were offered the jobs by various companies. On second day, in addition to Rozgar Mela, Skill exhibition for various job roles of construction sector was organized by CSTI Cuttack. L&T was the top recruiter with 87 candidates. The event was widely covered in print as well as in audio-visual mainstream media which includes Doordarshan Odisha, Kalinga TV, News7 and Statesman News Service.

The Rozgar Mela was very successful in attracting the local youth and their participation. The visiting youths were also briefed about the skilling efforts of the government through Construction SSC and large opportunities in the sector for skilled workforce.

The trainees gained 2 certifications from these programs-NSDC/CSDCI and QFI Certificate for Learning Achievement in Construction Work Supervision and Certificate of Professional Achievement in Planning and Delivering Training to Groups (Train The Master Trainers). The program were held at L&T CSTI Kanchipuram from 18th Feb to 28th February 2019. Mr. Jeremy Pilmore-Bedford (British Deputy High Commissioner Chennai), senior officials from TN Skill Development along with senior members from DFID, L&T and CEO, CSDCI attended the valedictory ceremony.
