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# CSDCI conducted first assessment after lockdown

CSDCI has conducted first **assessment** after lockdown on 13th and 14th June 2020 in Odisha for the job role of Rural Mason Level 4 under PMAY-G (RPL) by Mascot Upgrade skill and Knowledge Pvt. Ltd. Total 30 candidates were present for the assessment.



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Certain **steps** have been taken by the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (**MSDE**) to address the challenge posed by reverse migration - both domestic & international.

As part of the **Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan** coordinated by Ministry of Rural development, a detailed plan was prepared for skilling and reskilling of returning migrants in 116 districts of India. The D.O letters were prepared by MSDE and have already been sent to District Collectors, Chief Secretaries and Secretaries of Skill Development Departments for identifying & skill mapping the reverse migrants, jobrole identification for skilling and survey of eligible enterprises for apprenticeship. We are already aware that COVID-19 has created an unprecedented social and economic disruption leading to a large-scale reverse migration across the country. This migration is likely to cause a lot of stress on the local economy and society which is already under considerable stress due to COVID-19. Your district is one such district which has also received a large number of returning migrants. By the above activity, CSDCI is likely to get targets in RPL & STT in the above districts under PMKVY.

Also, in partnership with Ministry of Civil Aviation, the MSDE has started the scheme **SWADES (Skilled Workers Arrival Database for Employment Support)**, where the skill sets of migrants returning from abroad are captured at the time of boarding. The total number of registrations till 1st June 2020 were 4260. The top Sectors identified were Oil & Gas, **Construction**, Tourism & Hospitality, Automotive and Aviation. The top receiving Indian States were Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Karnataka and Telangana.



## Apprenticeship Corner

- The integration of the two apprenticeship portals - Designated Trades being administered by DGT and Optional Trades being administered by NSDC, was completed & now a single portal is in place.
- The apprentices cannot be covered for benefits under the ESIC Act. An establishment needs to explore other available govt/non govt. health insurance and pension schemes to ensure the health cover for apprentices which is the responsibility of the establishment under the Apprenticeship Act/Rules.
- CSDCI has successfully registered M/s Oval Infra Projects in the Apprenticeship Portal & opportunities were created.
