EXTENSION OF PMKVY 2.0 IN THE NORTH-EAST REGION

In view of the lockdown due to the COVID-19 crisis, MSDE has extended the last date to July 31, 2020 for the North-East region only, for Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna 2016 – 2020, provided that new / fresh enrolments will be done only for reverse migrant workers. Moreover, all training / orientation should start or resume within 30 days from the opening of the Training centres (TCs) and be completed before 31 October, 2020 and all Assessments and Certifications should be completed by 15 November, 2020. This Notification applies to the Training Providers (TPs)/ Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) that have balance targets under PMKVY 2016-20, against allocations in NER. CSDCI had earlier requested to NSDC for shifting 9000 unconsumed targets to North East. The activity has been initiated & the interest/willingness of the selected TPs was sought.

IDENTIFICATION & SKILL MAPPING OF REVERSE MIGRANTS IN 116 DISTRICTS OF INDIA

There was a communication from MSDE to district authorities regarding preparation of comprehensive database of reverse migrant workers because of issue created by COVID-19 pandemic. To help mitigate this crisis and support the State and District Administration, MSDE intends to take up District specific demand driven skilling for sustainable livelihood opportunities in these identified districts under PMKVY 2016-20 and Apprenticeship. The District Administration were requested to identify & Skill Map the Reverse migrants in the District and Survey of the eligible Enterprises for Apprenticeship at District Level.

CSDCI has also prepared it's readiness to take-up the task of training, assessment & certification of these migrant workers whenever the direction comes to us.
