Greeting from CSDCI!

This is to inform you that CSDCI has been allocated a total of 3750 targets for the RPL project under SANKALP. Now, CSDCI requires to partner with good organizations to implement the project.

1. The targets are to be implemented in two Phases:- Phase 1 – 1875 targets; Phase 2 – 1875
2. Phase 2 targets will released upon successful implementation of Phase 1.
3. A total of 2000 targets (1000 in Phase 1 and 1000 in Phase 2) are to be provided Bridge Course of 68 hours.
4. CSDCI is the PIA here & the selected TP will get a maximum of 600 targets.
5. CSDCI plans to select maximum 4 TPs for this project.
6. PIA shall validate the list of candidates provided by MoPR, and select the candidates who are employed by Gram Panchayat directly or through contractors working with Gram Panchayat.
7. PAI shall submit a report mentioning how many of the candidates have been taken from the already-provided list and how many are not listed in the list but are working with the Gram Panchayat and were certified under this project.
8. The project is to be implemented at two blocks in Varanasi namely Sewapuri and Baragaon, and two blocks in Chandauli namely Niamtabad and Shahabganj.

- For project implementation, kindly ensure that all on-boarded trainers for the project are TOT certified prior to initiation of any batch. You are requested to ensure utmost quality and transparency in execution of this project, in line with the Scheme/project guidelines.
- Orientation content shall be made available in regional languages of all proposed locations.
- All beneficiaries shall be given the RPL Skill Card during the Certificate Distribution Ceremony along with the RPL certificate.
- Every passed and certified RPL candidate shall be provided a 3 -year accidental insurance (Kaushal Bima) which covers up to Rs.2 lacs amount.
- PIA shall ensure provision of digital literacy, cashless transactions, BHIM app, Bharat QR Code, and entrepreneurship basics in the orientation content.
- PIA shall ensure extensive documentation of entire project through videography and photography as defined in the Term Sheet.
- Success stories of candidates shall be developed and disseminated widely on all media platforms (i.e. print, electronic and digital).
- PIA is required to inform candidates that the training/orientation and certification by NSDC/SSC is not in substitution of the statutory requirement of specific license/diploma/degree or any other certificate for taking up or performing the job for which there is a requirement under any statute for any specific license/diploma/degree or any other certificate for taking up or performing that job
- PIA shall inform District Magistrate (DM) office prior, during and completion of RPL activity in the respective DM's jurisdiction.
- Assessment Agencies that have credible experience of conducting assessments in Construction sector and in proposed locations shall be engaged for the project.

The selected TPs are to ensure:

1. **Undertaking cum Indemnity Bond is to be on Stamp Paper and as per Instructions.**
2. **Term sheet to be on A4-white paper (separate from undertaking cum indemnity bond).**
3. **Each page of Indemnity Bond and Term sheet signed and stamped by authorized personal from TP.**
