

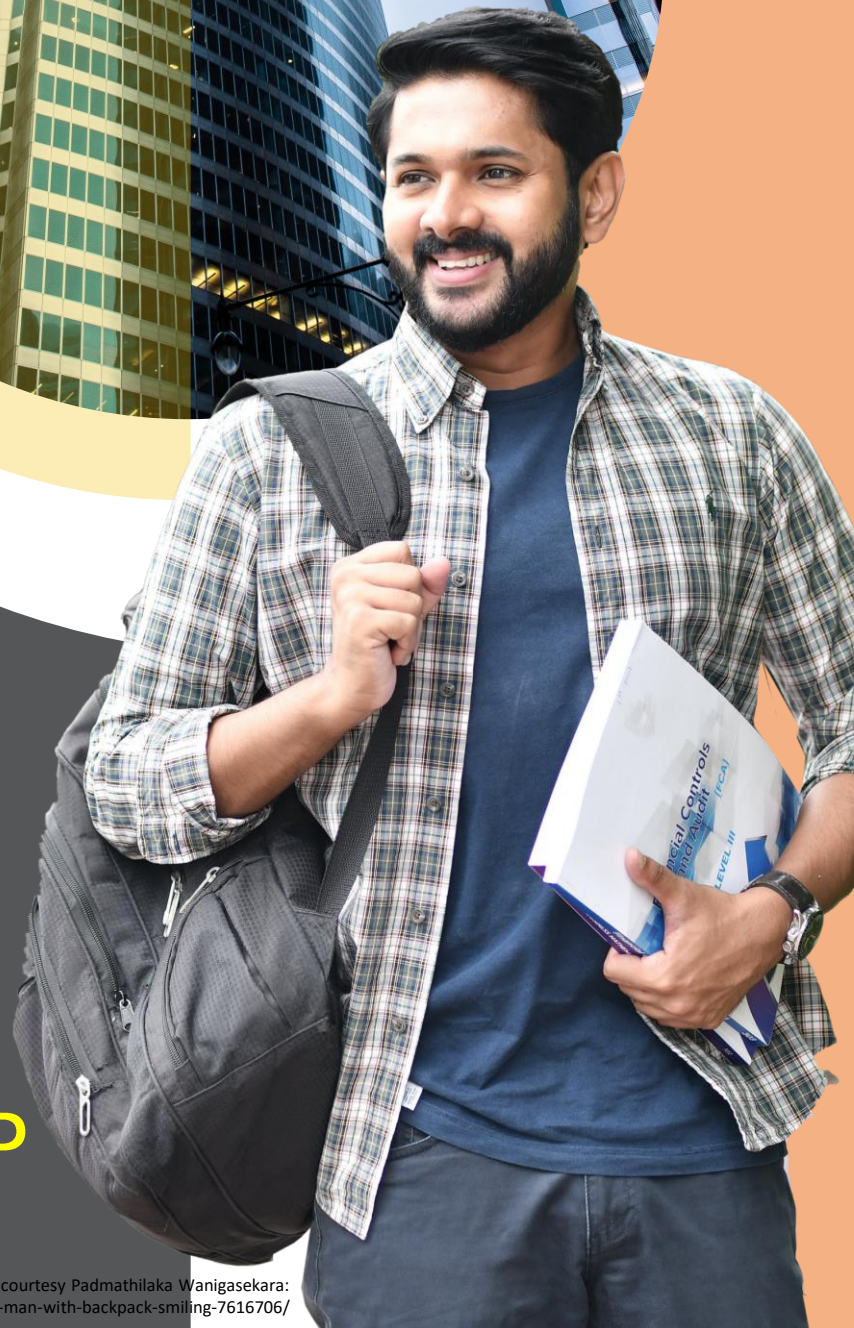

The student section provides a unique, open forum for students to engage with and learn from their peers and industry professionals. This helps foster community and allows them to learn from real-world experience and team collaboration. Student members may visit construction sites and manufacturing plants and participate in competitions.

In any academic institution, 25 student members must set up a student section. The HoD will head the team, followed by nominated roles depending on the student's willingness and abilities.

Student members can be from Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics, MBA Marketing, etc.

Subscription:

The student year membership subscription is INR 700/-; against the membership fee, students will get complimentary CSDCI publications worth more than INR 700/-, which means there is no membership subscription.

Each student will get:

CSDCI will be the platform for students to enhance their inherent skills such as Observation, Research, Outreach, and Business Acumen skills; apart from these basic skills, additional requirements for tomorrow's industry.

Networking:

Student Members of the CSDCI Student Chapter can participate in CSDCI outreach programs, creating the advantage of meeting other engineering student fraternities and working professionals. It's a great way to make new contacts and familiarity with connections that can help you throughout your career.

Group Discussions:

CSDCI encourages the student section to organize at least one technical session by inviting speakers from the industry. Team members will discuss and finalize the subject, reaching the respective sector.





Outreach:

Once the student section members decide on a topic and organization (CSDCI can help find the speakers), a team of two or three students will invite the speaker through the proper paperwork and channels.

Less dependency:

Participating in CSDCI outreach activities, meeting delegates at industry, and networking with industry will help students feel the drive to approach career opportunities with confidence independently.

Meaningful Volunteer Opportunities:

Today, the industry prefers candidates with a social responsibility who can help them implement CSR or participate in ISO 26000 (social responsibility standard).

CSDCI will encourage students to participate in RPL and occupational surveys at work sites, interact with workers, motivate them to lead a better life by acquiring additional skills with valid certificates, learn first responder/first aid techniques, etc.

Internships & Apprenticeship:

CSDCI Apprenticeship programs can help student members gain skills in their particular stream trade or career path in a cost-efficient and effective way.

Observation:

During the internship, Apprenticeship, Volunteering, industry visits, and participating in the outreach program, they will have opportunities to find/notice the real-time problems that can be addressed collaboratively with other branches (electrical, mechanical, etc).

Research:

Students can submit various research works, which CSDCI will publish and bring to the limelight, or what concepts or solutions students developed for the problem they observed in the actual field.

Outreach:

CSDCI will allow student members to develop products to showcase during CSDCI outreach events, expos, and skill competitions. This will bridge the gap between industry and academia and between academy and academy.
